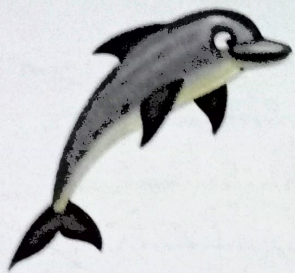

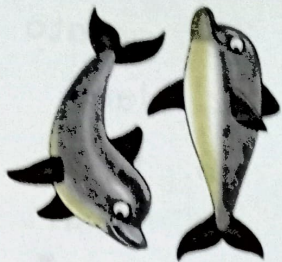

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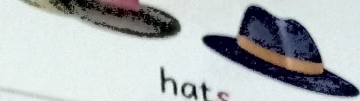

Nouns That End in -y

If a noun ends in **-y**, and the letter before the last letter is a vowel, we add **-s** to the noun to make its plural.



toy



toys



key



keys

If a noun ends in **-y**, and the letter before the last letter is a consonant, we drop the **-y** and add **-ies** to make its plural.

cherries

Adding **-ves**

We add **-ves** to some nouns that end in **-f** or **-fe** to make them plural. Remember **-f** or **-fe** is dropped from the plural.

However, in case of some nouns that end in **-f** or **-fe**, we add **-s** to them to make them plural.

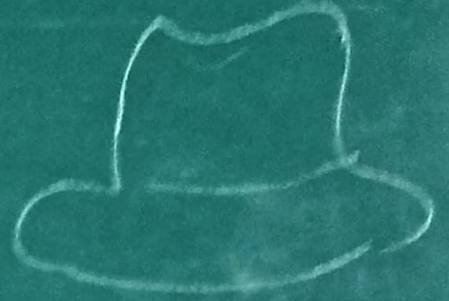
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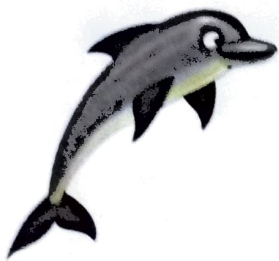

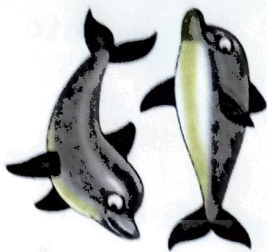
