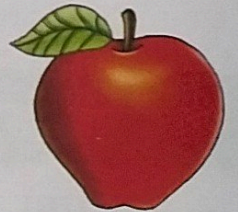

Let's Play Grammar

1. The hidden pictures

Your teacher will divide the class into four teams. Each team will be assigned one out of these pronouns: *it*, *he*, *she* and *they*. She will then hide pictures of people and objects around the classroom. Now, the students from each team have to collect the pictures of objects and people that can be replaced by the pronoun assigned to their team. The team that collects most pictures correctly in the shortest time wins.

2. Create your own pronoun flowers.

Each student will create a pronoun flower using paper. The teacher will assign one pronoun to each student. The flower will have the allotted pronoun at its centre, as shown in the picture. Around the centre, the students will paste cut-outs of petals with the names of the objects or people which that pronoun can replace. The flowers can be later displayed in class.
